## APPROVAL OF AGENDA:

The motion was made by Councilmember Whittle and seconded by Councilmember Belton to approve the agenda as written. A vote of 5-0 in favor was taken.

#### APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

Council Meeting, December 14, 2023 and Called Council Meeting December 29, 2023 were presented to the Council. A motion was made by Councilmember Smalley and seconded by Councilmember Belton to approve the minutes. A vote of 5-0 in favor was taken.

### **BUSINESS:**

2023 Budget Amendments: CA Waller explained that twice a year the City has amendments to address shortfalls and overages in the current budget. The end of year budget amendments totaled \$80,977.00. He presented an overview to the Council of these amendments. A motion by Councilmember Johnson and seconded by Councilmember Corley, passed with a vote of 5-0.
