

Thomson City Council Called Meeting Government Center Second Floor Meeting Room April 1, 2024 5:00 P.M.

Mayor Cranford brought the meeting to order at 5:13pm.

## **BUSINESS:**

The called meeting's purpose is to uphold or overturn the mayor's veto of Tentative Ordinance 585 – To Amend Section 2.07, Mayor Pro Tem, of the City of Thomson Charter.

CA Waller explained that the mayor vetoed, on March 15, 2024, the ordinance that was approved on March 14<sup>th</sup> during the City Council meeting. The Council has thirty days to override the veto with a 4/5 vote. Today is seventeen calendar days from the veto. After a short discussion among the Councilmembers, a motion to override the veto was made by Councilmember Belton and seconded by Councilmember Johnson. A vote taken of 3-2 was not sufficient to override the veto. The ordinance is null and void; the City Charter is not amended. The number of 585 will be removed from the tentative ordinance. The physical ordinance will be filed in the same manner as all other ordinances in the City Clerk's office and will remain un-numbered in the list of City Ordinances.

Mayor Cranford called the meeting adjourned at 5:34pm.
