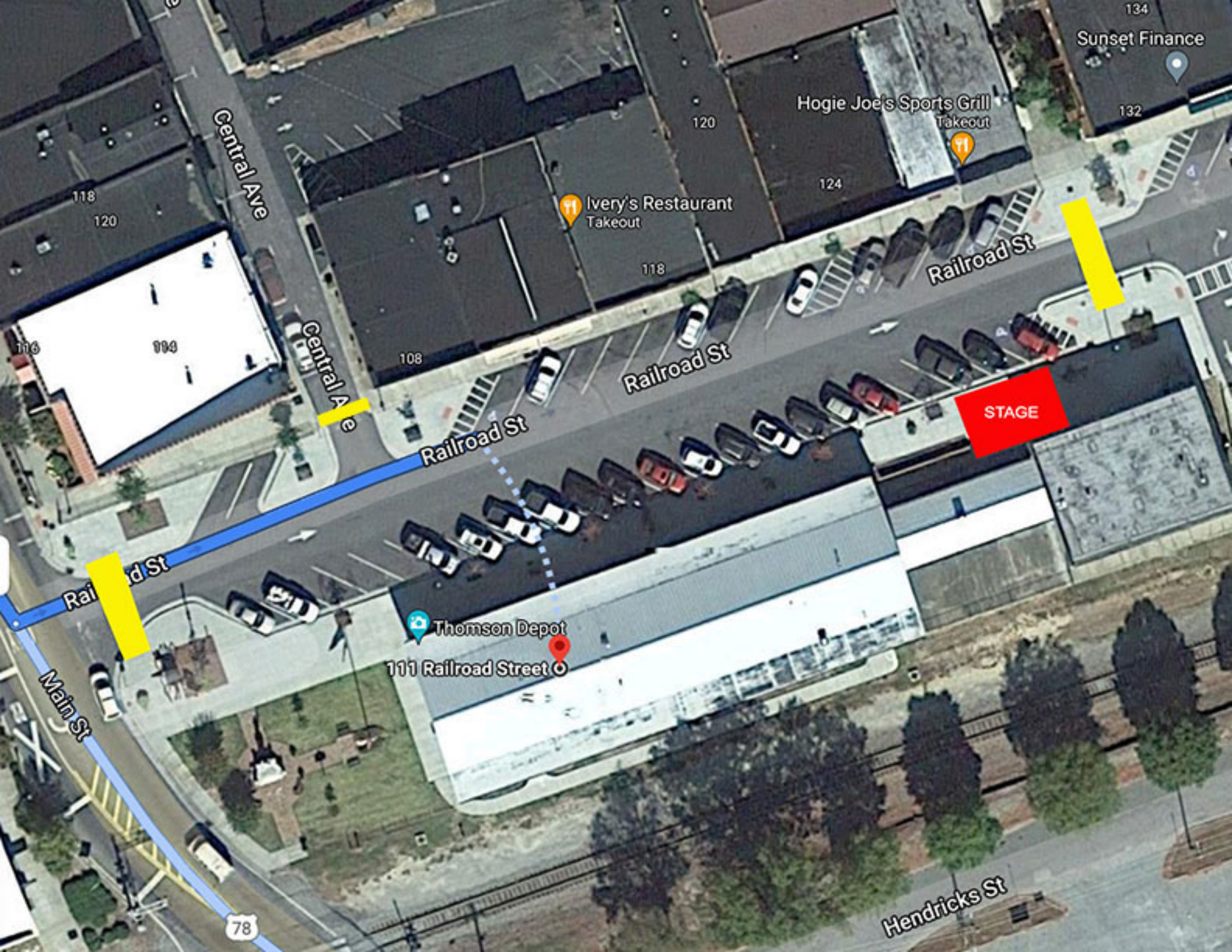
- Activation of Special Event Open Container Ordinance
