Dear Mayor Usry and members of the Thomson City Council,


I am writing to formally request the closure of Railroad Street, as well as other services, for two nights later this month to accommodate a traveling circus.

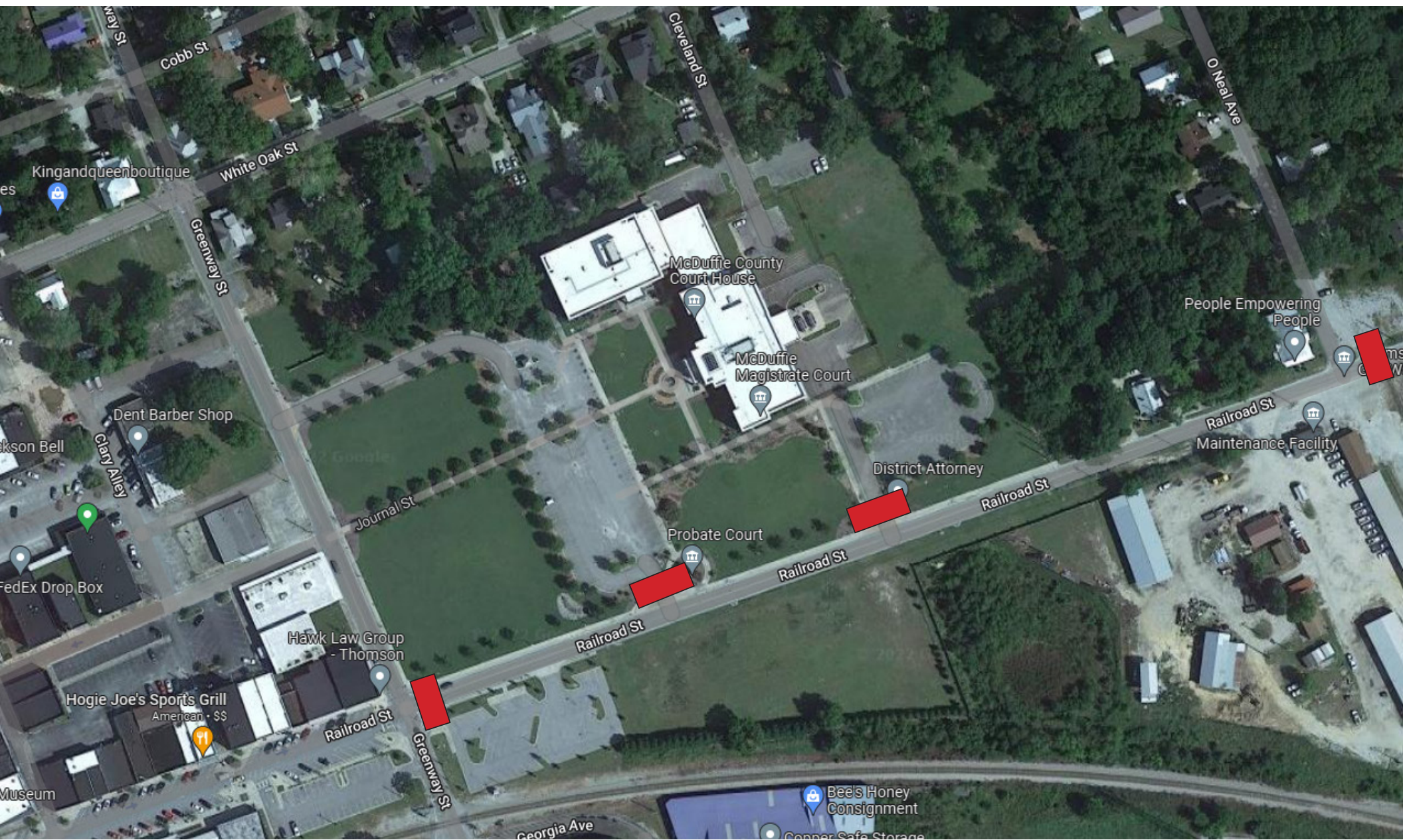

- Access to a water source such as a fire hydrant or other connection
- Access to electricity
