

## 2023 Elections Qualifying

Any voter desiring to become a candidate shall file a Notice of Candidacy in the office of the City Clerk, Lucretia Ferguson, 2<sup>nd</sup> floor, City-County Government Complex, beginning Wednesday, August 16, 8:30AM and ending on Friday, August 18, promptly at 12Noon. Qualifying will close at 4:30PM, Wednesday and Thursday.

Candidates for Mayor shall pay a qualifying fee of \$312.00.

Candidates for City Council shall pay a qualifying fee of \$222.00.

The seat for Mayor is elected at-large.

Each candidate for Council Member must reside in the district for which they qualify.

District 1-currently represented by Keryl Corley (A) and Scott Whittle (B);

District 2-currently represented by Alton Belton (B) and John Smalley (A);

District 3-currently represented by Doris (Elaine) Johnson.

Candidates for either Mayor or City Council shall be at least 21 years of age and a registered voter of said city. Candidates for City Council shall have been a resident of the district for which he/she offers at least 60 days prior to the date he/she qualifies as a candidate.
