Speed Cameras in School Zones in Thomson

Facts

- Intent is to reduce speeding vehicles in traveling through school zones; reduce collisions and potential tragedy; BLS reports they generally see 94% decrease in speeders
- LIDAR speed detection units will be set up in school zones and <u>run during school</u> <u>day</u>; all equipment provided by BLS no cost to City minus a few posts / some power (to operate the cameras)
- Warnings and heavy PR on front end (brochures to parents/cards given to teachers/bus drivers, newspaper, social media, etc.) – 1st 30 days
 - o then citations for anything **11mph+** over speed limit
- <u>Violation is photographed</u> and encrypted info is sent electronically through NLETS to BLS processing center in TN; <u>NO PHOTOS OF DRIVER</u>, ONLY VEHICLE
- <u>TPD post-certified officer</u> will receive data and have to <u>approve the citation</u> <u>batches</u> to verify info is accurate (tag matches photo); roughly 15 30 mins per day depending on volume
- GA Law sets **fine amount at \$75** with a \$25 processing fee (1st) and \$125 (2nd) and subsequent violations
- MOU with McDuffie County Sheriff's Department

 2% of revenue goes to schools per OCGA (state law)
- <u>Unpaid citations</u> can be <u>referred to the GA Dept of Revenue</u> to be settled up when tag renewal or sale of the title occur; several (3) notices are sent to registered owner; civil action, NOT criminal
- BLS processes payments: 65% if fine revenue sent to TPD; 35% to BLS
- BLS sets up a website and works with Municipal Court to set up court dates, letters to violator, and court packets

- Each month BLS provides a report with analytics, amount collected, agency's revenue, and a check
- <u>6 to 9 months</u> from <u>contract approval to execution</u> (due to GDOT permit protocols for speed detection device
 - o If approved now, target live date for would be January 2024
- BLS already in place: Savannah, City of Jefferson, South Fulton, Temple, Oglethorpe County, Ringgold
