FRONT ENTRY DESIGN



Keeping the original form of the roundabout layout and increasing the road depth, a 50' fire lane can be added. The original roundabout was 65' in diameter, so making the new design 35' will allow access for emergency vehicles to move in and out of the space. Refacing the original sign and placing it next to the flagpole will create a welcoming and low-maintenance entry.











PICKLE BALL BUILDING



The parking lot can be redesigned to provide more space for vehicle access - this can be done by extending the existing parking lot further south into the field. The parking lot can have little islands with trees to provide shade. Provided are building precedents: open air, fully enclosed, or partially open.

MULTI-SPORT FIELD



Since there is a large portion of unprogrammed space, putting it in a multipurpose and separate baseball field is possible. There are types of multipurpose fields that incorporate multiple sports into one area. In addition, adding trees to places where people usually gather and spaces throughout the park will create more shade and comfort for those visiting.







Adding a community garden might allow the city/county to rent out plots to those interested in having their gardens at the park—a great way for neighbors and community members to work together and build community relationships.


PRECEDENTS FOR COMMUNITY GARDEN







SHADE STRUCTURES



Utilizing trees and shade structures throughout the park can create spaces for patrons to sit and watch the games, spend time with each other, or relax in the shade. Covering the playground with a shade structure might increase its use during the harsher times of the day.
